



Macaws - Have brightly colored feathers which can be red, blue, yellow and green - Are one of the most and expensive exotic birds - Include several of the most species on earth












- · Are known for their unique mechanism which allows them to swell with water when threatened





Amphibians Are cold blooded animals with skin which may live on land or in water Are usually or brown in color May possess dark spots or stripes Can usually be kept with fish






